

## Formal Contest of Toll Violation

**NOTICE:** Under Kansas law, the registered owner of the vehicle is responsible for tolls accrued. Leased/rented vehicles do not qualify for formal contest. If any of the reasons listed below apply to your violation, please fill out page two of this form and provide the required documentation. Reasons such as missed getting ticket, didn't see signs, or unfamiliar with area are not valid reasons to formally contest a toll violation.

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION AND INSTRUCTIONS:** Identify the reason for your dispute from the list below and carefully follow instructions and submit required documentation.

### 1) **K-TAG Accounts**

- The K-TAG transponder must be mounted properly and the account in good standing at time of the violation.
- For K-TAG customers, K-TAG account number should be included in your dispute explanation.

### 2) **Sold** (provide *one* of the following)

- Copy of Bill of Sale. Must indicate date of sale<sup>1</sup>. Must include the names and signatures of the seller and the buyer. Must include the make, model, year, and vehicle identification number (VIN).
- Plate Revocation or Cancellation Confirmation Form. Must indicate date of revocation<sup>1</sup> or cancellation<sup>1</sup>, as well as license plate number.
- Motor Vehicle Query Report from your Department of Motor Vehicles showing you were not the owner at the time of the violations. Must indicate license plate number.
- Certificate of Vehicle Title Transfer. Must indicate date of transfer<sup>1</sup>.
- Court Order transferring ownership of vehicle. Must indicate date of transfer<sup>1</sup> and license plate number or VIN.
- Auto Auction Documentation. Must be on auction letterhead. Must include VIN, date of sale<sup>1</sup>, and the name and address of both the seller and the buyer.

### 3) **Stolen** (provide *one* of the following)

- Police Report. Must include license plate number and date of the incident<sup>1</sup>. The report must be signed and dated by a Police Officer and must indicate the Police Officer's badge number. (Submitting a case number is not acceptable. You must obtain and submit the report.)
- Insurance (theft) Payoff Report. Must indicate the date of the incident<sup>1</sup> and vehicle information (license plate, make, and model).

### 4) **Divorced** (provide *one* of the following)

- Divorce Decree transferring ownership of vehicle. Must indicate the date of transfer<sup>1</sup>.
- Court Order transferring ownership of vehicle. Must include the name of the ex-spouse who is responsible for the violation.
- Certificate of Vehicle Title Transfer. Must indicate the date of transfer<sup>1</sup>.

### 5) **Deceased**

- Death Certificate
  - If there are two registered owners listed for the vehicle, the second owner is liable for the violation notice.
  - Any violations incurred after the date of death will not be dismissed.

### 6) **Incorrect Registered Owner** (provide *one* of the following)

- Registered Owner Documentation proving ownership of a vehicle bearing the same license plate number but a different plate type or jurisdiction as the violating vehicle.
- Motor Vehicle Query Report from your Department of Motor Vehicles showing you were not the owner at the time of the violations. Must indicate license plate number.

### 7) **Repossessed** (provide of the following)

- Notice of Repossession Document that states date vehicle was repossessed<sup>1</sup>. Must indicate license plate number.

<sup>1</sup> Date must be prior to the violations in dispute.

 **Leased/Rented Vehicle:** Leased/rented vehicles do not qualify for formal contest. Tolls are the responsibility of the vehicle's registered owner.
